What is the UCG Endowment Fund?

We in the United Church of Gainesville are truly generous people. Be it a Habitat house, or the extension of the new west wing to the fellowship hall, disaster relief, or someone in need, we respond with open hearts.

In 1999 Irene Zimmerman showed that generosity when she left about \$125,000 in her will to the church. She also gave about \$50,000 from the proceeds of the sale of her house, which helped refurbish the Fellowship Hall. Both are gifts we will treasure for years.

Following her bequest, the UCG Endowment Fund was established. Others have added to the fund since, totaling \$128,451 as of May, 2009. The sum is modest, but it has already filled church needs that otherwise would not have been met.
